**Name of problem** Communications Server 1000 (CS 1000) CPPM Service Packs Fail to Install Due to Lack of Hard Disk Space  
**Products affected**

Communications Server (CS) 1000E: Release 6.0.x, 7.0.x, and 7.5.x.

Communications Server (CS) 1000M: Release 6.0.x, 7.0.x, and 7.5.x.

**Problem description**

This document provides information on reported issues from the field regarding CPPM Services packs failing to install due to a lack of hard disk space. This is only applicable to CPPM Co-Res configurations.

The root cause of this issue is a combination of the partition sizes used in the CPPM Co-Res configuration, the size of Linux Service Packs and the temporary files that are contained on the CPPM hard disk.

**Resolution**

Avaya has implemented fixes in Release 7.0 and 7.5 Services packs as of September 2012. Please make sure systems are up to date with the latest services packs of October or newer for release 7.0 and 7.5.

For CS 1000 Release 6.0, please follow the process outlined in the Workaround or Alternative Remediation section. This is a multi-step manual process to free up disk space that can be used. Another alternative which may be easier is to re-image the CPPM drive.

**Workaround or alternative remediation**

As an alternative solution, please use the following process to install the service pack including the steps to manually free up disk space for service pack installation:

1. Download the latest service pack from Avaya ESPL page and read the Release notes with disk space requirement.  
Disk space requirements:  
/var partition should have (2x'SP size')+200MB available disk space, e.g. if SP is 1.2G, then /var should have 2.6G free disk space.
2. ssh to PSS server, use "df -h" command to check free disk space. If there is enough free disk space, then go to step 4.
3. If there is not enough free disk space, use the procedure "How to free up disk space".
4. Admin logins into UCM Patch Manger page to upload the SP to PM, then installs the SP.

**How to free up disk space**

If during SP installation there is not enough disk space (2xService Pack size + 200MB), you should follow these steps to free up additional disk space.

**If you want to free up disk space on "/admin" partition:**

Remove \*.nai file(s) from the system. Log in to UCM and go to Software Deployment -> Software Loads. Select \*.nai load(s) and click 'Delete' button.

**If you want to free up disk space on "/var" partition:**

- 1) Remove patching content.

Log in to UCM and go to Patches -> Patches and select one of the three targets:

**Service Packs & Deplists** – if you want to remove Service Packs/Deplists;

**Patches** – if you want to remove patches;

**Loadware** – if you want to remove Loadware file(s);

Select unnecessary Patch Content and click 'Delete' button.

- 2) Clean up backup archives.

Log in to UCM and go to Software Deployment -> Backups page, select backup(s), and click 'Delete' button. You can save your backup files on remote servers (SFTP backup).

- 3) Remove any files from "/var/opt/nortel/patch/sp". Login as nortel (Release 7.0) or admin2 (Release 7.5) on CS1000 and invoke:

- 4) To free up temporary disk space consumed by patching operations.

It is necessary to clear completed activities in Patching Manager. All ongoing operations on targets can be viewed in the "In Progress" tab. Options are given to proceed with patching activation once patching impact assessment is completed (in manual mode) or to clear completed operations. Both should be done promptly to free up space and allow other patching of any other targets to proceed.

- 5) Clean up old logs from “/var/log/nortel/old\_logs/”. Login as nortel (Release 7.0) or admin2 (Release 7.5) user on CS1000, enter root shell by ‘su -‘ and invoke:

- 6) Clean up two Jboss log folders on the Primary UCM:

These folders are: “/var/opt/nortel/Jboss-Quantum/conf/quantum-config/securityserver/stats/” and “/var/opt/nortel/Jboss-Quantum/conf/quantum-config/securityserver/log/”

If you want to backup these files before deletion and copy to sftp server, then invoke (under root):

- 7) Clean up SPS logs (if NRS applications are deployed). Login as nortel (Release 7.0) or admin2 (Release 7.5) user on CS1000 and invoke:

- 8) Uninstall previously applied patches. Uninstall all patches one by one via CLI using poos, pout commands. Login as nortel (Release 7.0) or admin2 (Release 7.5) user on CS1000 and invoke:
