Name of problem CM upgrade paths.

Products affected

Avaya Aura® Communication Manager (CM), Releases 2.0 – 7.x

Problem description

This PSN is informational only and specifies CM upgrade paths in the Resolution section.

Due to the overlapping nature and timing of CM release launches, it is not always possible to upgrade from a lower release to a higher release without the possibility of encountering corruption or having a needed fix or enhancement not be available in the higher release. Therefore, not all CM upgrade paths are supported. The information presented in this document should be used to determine supported CM upgrade paths.

The upgrade path depends on which, if any, Service Pack is installed.

Resolution

For CM 7.0.0.0.0 and later releases refer to Product Documentation for determining upgrade paths and procedures from older CM releases to CM 7.0.0.0.0 and higher releases.

The upgrade paths in the following table account for both CM internal data translation records as well as 100% inclusion of current software fixes. Note that any CM 2.x release prior to CM 2.2.2 can use the CM 2.2.2 upgrade paths and that any CM 3.x release prior to CM 3.1.4 can use the CM 3.1.4 upgrade paths.

In general, only upgrades to currently supported releases are supported by Avaya. See the current product or offer definition documents for details. Upgrade paths to earlier non-supported releases are shown for historical purposes only.
