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1. Purpose

The release notes provide information about the GA version of the Call Management System (CMS) R18.x software. The release notes include last minute information that is not incorporated into the standard documentation as well as a very high level of the release content.

3. CMS R18.1 Functionality

The CMS R18.1 release provides the following platform and feature support:

3.1. *CMS R18.1 CMS Platform support*

The CMS R18.1 release supports the following platforms:

- Support for new sales on the Avaya Solutions Platform.
- Continued support for virtualized deployment on VMWare, this includes new sales and upgrades to existing VMWare deployments.
- Support upgrades on existing servers: Dell R220, Dell 620, Dell R630, Dell 720, Dell R730, HP DL20, HP DL380 G8, and HP DL380 G9.
- Support for existing servers to an Avaya Solutions Platform or VMWare deployment.
- Support for upgrades is not supported on all Oracle servers.

3.2. *Communication Manager 8.0 support*

This release allows customers to connect their CMS to Communication Manager 8.0.

Communication Manager 8.0 provides the following notable features for CMS customers:

- Up to 16 digits for agent login IDs, station extensions and VDN extensions. Vector administration is still limited to 13 digits for agent login IDs and VDN extensions.
- Support for up to 30,000 measured trunks per Communication Manager system and 100,000 system-wide (previous maximums: per Communication Manager system - 24,000; system-wide 80,000)
- Support for up to 9,999 trunks per trunk group (previous maximum: 250)

3.3. *Local Area Network (LAN) Backup/Restore Improvements*

- Support LAN backup and restore in Virtualized environment. This provides support for specific IBM Spectrum Protect (formerly Tivoli) and Netbackup client/server client/server products.
 - Note that a fresh (aka new) install of CMS 18.1.0.0 is required to enable the LAN backup functionality in a Virtual environment. This is due to the need to specifically allocate disk space to manager the LAN backup.
 - Customers on releases of CMS R18 prior to R18.1.0.0 cannot simply upgrade to CMS 18.1.0.0 and begin performing LAN backups in a virtual environment.
 - LAN backups on a hardware server are not affected and continue to operate as normal.

4. 18.1.0.4 Information

4.1 Bugs Fixes in 18.1.0.4

The following **CMS Server** fixes have been added to **CMS R18.1.0.4**

- The call history record (Internal and External Call History) value for queuetime is incorrect when a direct agent call is recorded. This fix allows the correct queuetime value to be recorded in the call history record.
- In a rare call scenario involving a conference while a call ringing and a RONA, the link to the CM may drop. This is a defensive fix to prevent the link drop.
- Tenant Users were receiving a “No Permissions” error when running reports that take an agent name or logid as an input, such as the Historical Agent Split/Skill Summary Daily report, if the sum total of all agents assigned to the tenant(s) the user had permissions for was greater than 32,000. For example, tenant 1 is assigned 8000 agents, tenant 2 has 16,000 agents, tenant 25 has 10,000 agents, and tenant 50 has 20,000 agents. This is a total of 54,000 agents across all the tenants. If tenant login ‘abc’ had permissions for all tenants (1, 2, 25 and 50), ‘abc’ would erroneously receive a permissions error when attempting to run the Historical Agent Split/Skill Summary Daily report. With this fix, ‘abc’ is able to run the Historical Agent Split/Skill Summary Daily report successfully.

The following **CMS Supervisor PC** fixes have been added to **CMS R18.1.0.4**:

NOTE: the CMS R18 PC Supervisor client MB.08 was not updated. Avaya recommends customer use the latest client which is the R19 CMS Supervisor PC client. CMS Supervisor PC Client R19 is backward compatible with CMS R18.1.x deployments.

5. 18.1.0.3 Information

5.1. VMWare Deployment Caveats for 18.1.0.3

CMS R18.1.0.3 and later releases support deployment in VMware ESXi 6.7.

CMS R18.1.0.3 and later releases continue to support deployment in VMware ESXi 5.5, 6.0 and 6.5.

However, in supporting all these versions of ESXi, there is a caveat when installing the CMS R18.1.0.x OVA file in VMware ESXi 5.5 and 6.0.

A warning message will appear during ova deployment on an ESXi 5.5 and 6.0 server.

The warning can be ignored, and deployment continued.

The following warnings appear during OVA deployment:

5.2. *Bugs Fixed in 18.1.0.3*

The following CMS Server fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.3

- Tomcat container upgraded to latest 8.5 version. Tomcat update includes Ghostcat update and miscellaneous bug fixes.
- Fix for Integrated report when the skill state column is incorporated twice in the same table.
- Fix for Integrated report with a CWC input value.
- Fix for link drop when Change Agent Skills Direct agent skill field is blank. This is an incorporation of R18.1.0.2 Patch #1.
- Fix for ECH record size of extended ECD format. This is an incorporation of R18.1.0.2 Patch #2.
- Fix to revert skill and VDN call profiles work based back to tracking the times of the last VDN & skill used before answer or abandon. This is an incorporation of R18.1.0.2 Patch #3.
- Fix for inflated time spent in VDN based on vectors flowing to other vectors.
- Update CMS handling of transfers completed by unstaffed extensions to reduce the number of ignored and abandoned calls.
- Fix for VDN report issue when vdn is greater than 11 digits.

The following CMS Supervisor Web fix have been added to CMS R18.1.0.3:

- Fix for password change issue when password includes \$ anywhere but as last character.

The following CMS Supervisor PC fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.3:

NOTE: the CMS R18 PC Supervisor client MB.08 was not updated. Avaya recommends customer use the latest client and CMS Supervisor PC Client R19 NB.02 is backward compatible with CMS R18.1.x deployments. The following fixes are provided in the R19 PC Supervisor client NB.02.

- CMS PC Supervisor Forms now support high resolution (4K) displays.
- If a CMS user account cannot be created in User Data form because the chosen login is reserved, a “Reserved User-ID” message is displayed on the status bar of the form.
- An error has been corrected that prevented the ACD Status screen from being displayed when connected to an R19 CMS server.
- An error has been corrected in the Browse dialog to ensure content is filtered by user permissions.
- An error has been corrected that prevented the VDN Access menu from being displayed on systems with LDAP enabled.

The following fixes were provided in earlier versions of the CMS Supervisor PC Client:

- Improved client resiliency when users make multiple attempts to change passwords reusing old passwords.
- Fixed issue introduced in R19 PC Supervisor client NA.11 where automatic scripts would not execute properly
- Fixed issue where the legend border option was disabled when data item labels are edited.

- No longer will an extra skill be selected when selecting multiple skills for single agent using the ctrl key to multi-select from the skills list.

6. 18.1.0.2 Information

6.1. VMWare Deployment Caveats for 18.1.0.2

CMS R18.1.0.2 supports deployment in VMWare ESXi 6.7.

CMS R18.1.0.2 continues to support deployment in VMWare ESXi 5.5, 6.0 and 6.5.

However, in supporting all these versions of ESXi, there is a caveat when installing the CMS R18.1.0.2 OVA file in VMWare ESXi 5.5 and 6.0.

A warning message will appear during ova deployment on an ESXi 5.5 and 6.0 server.

The warning can be ignored, and deployment continued.

The following warnings appear during OVA deployment:

6.2. Bugs Fixed in 18.1.0.2

The following **CMS Server** fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.2

- Fixed an issue where the monthly archiver can core dump if CMS has tenancy enabled, and monthly data summation causes an overflow.
- Defensive fix to prevent the link to CM from dropping if an un-logged in agent handles an ACD call. While the link will not drop, the call is ignored by CMS.
- Will not ignore calls where an agent is service observing another agent who has conferenced in more than one non-logged in agent or unmeasured trunk.
- Corrected a minor error in trunk group reports for trunk groups with more than 256 members.
- Allow a skill on the agents skill list in position 61 to be assigned as the direct agent skill via Change Agent Skill.
- WebClient port is no longer locked up after a network scan.

The following **CMS Supervisor Web** fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.2:

- Allow query names to be longer than 20 characters for custom designer reports.
- Some custom calculations failed to execute in the web client, this has been resolved.

The following **CMS Supervisor PC** fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.2:

NOTE: the CMS R18 PC Supervisor client MB.08 was not updated.

The following fixes are provided in the R19 PC Supervisor client NA.13. Avaya recommends customer use the latest client and CMS Supervisor PC Client R19 NA.13 is backward compatible with CMS R18.1.x deployments.

- Improved client resiliency when users make multiple attempts to change passwords reusing old passwords.
- Fixed issue introduced in R19 PC Supervisor client NA.11 where automatic scripts would not execute properly
- Fixed issue where the legend border option was disabled when data item labels are edited.
- No longer will an extra skill be selected when selecting multiple skills for single agent using the ctrl key to multi-select from the skills list.

7. 18.1.0.1 information

7.1. Enhancements in 18.1.0.1

- CMS server security has been enhanced with stronger file access restrictions by modifying permissions on various files. See Appendix C for a list of file permission changes.
- Agent Count reports are now available that provide the customer the ability to see the number of agents logged in, by interval, for the maximum number of intervals retained. Customers can save copies of the report (for example, exporting the report or off-loading the data), for a longer-term view of agent usage can be obtained. The Agent Count report is available in the ASCII interface under
Reports->Historical->Agent->Agent Count

7.2. Bugs Fixed in 18.1.0.1

The following **CMS Server** fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.1

- Defensive fix is included to prevent CM link bounce when a Direct Agent Call (DAC) is forwarded over an unmeasured trunk. Note that all trunks used for call center operations must be measured.
- Permission checking failed when a pseudo ACD was numbered greater than 11.

The following **CMS Supervisor Web** fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.1:

- Report run in CMS Web failed when a numeric list was present in an 'in' clause in the custom report definition.

The following **CMS Supervisor PC** fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.1:

- Bug fixes March 2019 in MB.08
 - When adding skills to an agent, PC Supervisor automatically selected the first skill alphabetically. If the user began by using the ctrl key to select skills, the first skill is selected. This has been corrected such that no skills are selected by default. The user my select all skills to add to an agent.

- After copy and edit of a real time graphical report, if the report was saved before execution (instead of just executing the changed report), the border around the chart disappeared.
- When running the Integrated Agent Information report, the Staffed Time and Aux Time measures do not tally.
- When adding a skill to an agent, if the user clicks ok more than one time, the skill will be added to the selection the number of times 'ok' was clicked.
- PC Supervisor not properly recognizing password reuse and can hang when the server is configured to restrict password reuse.
- Report headings were exported as "****" when the 'time as seconds' option was not selected for the report
- Supervisors were able to delete an agent skill when the Supervisor did not have permission for that skill, when skill changes were completed by template. All permission checking is now enforced properly for agent skill changes via template.

8. Bugs fixed in 18.1.0.0

The following CMS Server fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0.0

- Floating point calculation issues in specific report queries.
- Storage.def file created incorrectly with converter.
- Upgrade Tomcat container to latest version.
- rt_gem process memory leaks.
- Data collection issue: problems with transfers and conferences.
- aom_admin fails to add snmp users.

The following CMS Supervisor Web fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0:

- Localization problem with historical:split/skill:Preferred Skill Level Summary (D/M/W) reports.
- Resolve web client vulnerabilities found during web client scan.
- Set focus on flash based reports when flash initializes.
- Implement updates for CEC standard for security related headers.
- Web client Designer Report display issues for normal users when flags=272.
- Web client cause tables to extend to the bottom of the screen regardless of whether this will obscure other objects (tables or otherwise).

The following CMS Supervisor PC fixes have been added to CMS R18.1.0:

- Data inaccurate when a query is duplicated in a single designer report.
- Error prevents Export All Data Report function.
- Numeric User ID inconsistency in PC Supervisor vs terminal client.

- Report ownership issue: normal supervisor user can edit and save the designer report of an administrator directly.
- Client / server connection not closed down completely in all scenarios; consumes licenses.
- Results not displayed for interactive scripting of change (multi) agent skills.
- Trace log settings multiplied (number of logs, log file sizes).
- Selecting multiple agents for report input via browse button generates incorrect query.
- Scripting not working for Tenant administration operations.
- Name-formatted fields displayed as numbers for columns added to (Agent & VDN) Designer reports.
- Headings exported incorrectly when "Seconds" option not selected in Report Export Data function.
